Earlier this year, when their situation felt hopeless, the village leader brought Baby to Bethel, and her life has changed dramatically. At Bethel, she found not only a safe place, but also love, care, friendship, and education.

Baby is studying in first grade. She is full of joy and dreams of becoming a police officer - determined to serve and protect others.
