Expectations

We believe there are some things that will help make this the most positive experience possible. The following expectations should be taken seriously and are designed to help us all commit to growing during our confirmation class.

- Class participation – Students should attend all Wednesday evening classes from 6:30 to 8:00pm. If a class is missed, you will need to make it up with Trentell before attending the next scheduled class. When you are in class, we expect you to be fully present and engaged (participating in activities, discussion, etc.)
- Church involvement – Horizons members are expected to be involved in our church. For our youth, this means attending worship, Fusion Sunday mornings and midweek (as 8th graders and Arise as 9th graders) and other youth events.
- Serving – Horizons members are encouraged to be open to how God wants them to use their spiritual gifts.
- Fusion retreat - Our retreat in the spring is requirement for confirmation class.
- Outside classroom involvement – All students are required to do 4 hours of community service. They can count 30 minutes of each Fusion midweek night if they would like to use that (dates and times on other side). Some alternate ideas are:
 - Peoples City Mission
 - Matt Talbot
 - Food Bank
 - Humane Society
 - Helping a neighbor with yard work, house work, etc.
- At-home component – Most weeks, we will send home activities and discussion guides for families. These will reinforce the Wednesday lessons and will be very important in the personal growth of the students. We ask that both students and parents take these seriously and commit to doing them each week.
